2009 Rules

Circuit Champions in All classes

Must show under all four judges

Exclusive Hi-point N.J. exhibitor award

Must sign up in show office before the start of the show.

You have to be a resident of the state of New Jersey. A combination of all four shows

Hi-point Horseman's riding club member

You must sign up in the office before the start of the show.

You have to be a current member of the Horseman's Assn.

This is a combination of all four shows.

Hi-point all around amateur,

This is a combination of all four shows. It is calculated according to A.Q.H.A. rules.

Hi-point all around youth 14-18 & 13 & under

This is a combination of all four shows and it is calculated according to A.Q.H.A. rules.

Hi-point all around novice amateur & novice youth

Points are combined for all four shows and halter is not mandatory, but your halter points will be counted if you participate in the youth or amateur halter.

Hi-point all around Jr. & Sr. open horse

This is a combination of all four shows and goes according to A.Q.H.A. rules for all around competition.

Hi-point Halter awards

This award will be given to all divisions of open, amateur & youth classes. The horse that receives the most A.Q.H.A. points will be the hi-point winner. Please keep in mind that the grand & reserve counts.

Hi-point all around trail award

You must sign up in the show office before the start of the show. To be eligible for this award the same horse and rider need to show in the following classes. You must show in an open halter class, Jr or Sr. trail class and Jr. or Sr. western pleasure. You must show in each event **all four days**.

PERFORMANCE HALTER CLASSES

You must present evidence of your R.O.M. to the show secretary to participate in your respective class.
